Computer Science and Engineering Technology Summer Camp Students Learning to Build Prototypes Circuits

CORPUS CHRISTI, Texas – Incoming freshmen participating in the Computer Science and Engineering Technology (CSET) Summer Camp will get hands-on experience in building circuit board prototypes for digital counters Friday, Aug. 8, from 10 a.m. to noon in the Center for Instruction, Room 226.

The week-long CSET camp introduces 30 freshmen students to computer science, engineering technology and critical thinking. The camp targets students who are not already committed to a technology degree.

Each student who successfully completes the summer camp and takes either Introduction to Problem Solving with Computers or Introduction to Interactive Design and Programming during the fall 2008 semester will receive a \$1,000 scholarship.
