Two Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi Students Attend NATA's iLead Student Leadership Program

CORPUS CHRISTI, Texas – Andrea Gonzalez and Clint Johnson, students in the athletic training program at Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi, attended the National Athletic Trainers' Association's (NATA) inaugural iLead Student Leadership Program held Feb.21-23 in Washington, D. C.

iLead is constructed around a series of educational and interactive sessions that are specially designed to provide key information to help students lead and communicate better as they enter the workforce and represent the athletic training profession.

Presentations from industry executives and association members focused on how the changing world is affecting the athletic training profession, determining one's leadership style to work together more effectively, improving communication and job seeking skills, among other timely topics.
