Texas A&M-Corpus Christi Mechanical Engineering Program Receives a \$30,000 Commitment from LNV Engineering

CORPUS CHRISTI, Texas – LNV Engineering, Inc. has committed \$30,000 toward the mechanical engineering program at Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi.
