## **BFA Candidate Exhibits Feature a Variety of Art Forms**

CORPUS CHRISTI, Texas – The Department of Art at Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi presents an opening reception for four Bachelor of Fine Arts candidates on Thursday, Nov. 5, from 6-8 p.m. in the Center for the Arts and the Mary and Jeff Bell Library.

The exhibitions will be on display through Saturday, Nov. 21. The artists and the exhibitions are as follows:

- **“Breakfast at Versailles” by Amanda Calhoun:** Calhoun’s exhibition consists of ceramics, sculpture, and screen-printing cumulating into a visual display inspired by 18th century French romanticism.
- **“Modern Empathy” by Christine Gomez:** Gomez’s paintings strive to show a relationship between everyday organic and mechanical objects.
- **“Material Illusions” by Millie Harrison:** The exhibition consist of a series of black and white prints inspired by the heavily layered images reflected in storefront window and the intense activity surrounding them.
- **“It Felt So Soft” by Jade Flowers:** The exhibition focuses on the human form, creating elegant but morbid works that mirror familiar, fascinating situations.
