

PROCEDURES FOR CO-CURRICULAR SERVICES

University Procedure 11.99.99.C5.01—Approved September 30, 2003
Supplements University Rule 11.99.99.C5

1. REQUIREMENTS INVOLVING PARENTS/GUARDIANS

- 1.1 Parents/guardians of minors participating in co-curricular services on campus must give written permission for their minor to participate.
- 1.2 Parents/guardians are responsible for remaining with their minor on campus during these services, as appropriate. When not appropriate for parents/guardians to remain in the same room with their minor, parents/guardians should remain in the near vicinity to assist with any issues that may arise.
- 1.3 Parents/guardians will supply the University with emergency medical information and a Waiver of Liability/Consent to Treat before their minor may receive co-curricular services on campus.

2. PROCEDURES INVOLVING COOPERATING AGENCIES

For co-curricular activities that occur off-campus, the University and the cooperating agency shall have a memorandum of understanding that outlines the procedures students must follow to deliver services through the cooperating agency.
