APPLICATION PROCEDURE

For full consideration, applications should be submitted before the following deadlines: December 15, 2008 for the Spring semester; May 1, 2009 for the Summer; and August 1, 2009 for the Fall 2009 semester. In addition, students must be admitted to a graduate program at Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi and have a complete file (all test scores, previous college transcripts and statement of purpose on file at the Office of Graduate Studies and Research).
