



## IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

### Proof of Immunization or Naturally-Acquired Immunity- REQUIRED

VACCINE	REQUIREMENT	REQUIRED FOR
Measles (Rubeola)	Two (2) doses of live measles vaccine (combined measles-mumps-rubella/MMR meets requirement), with first dose at 12 months of age or later and second dose at least 28 days after first dose <b>OR</b> Laboratory/Titer evidence for immunity	Students born in or after 1957
Mumps	One (1) dose at 12 months of age or later (MMR meets requirement) <b>OR</b> Laboratory/Titer evidence for immunity.	Students born in or after 1957
Rubella (German Measles)	One (1) dose at 12 months of age or later (MMR meets requirement) <b>OR</b> Laboratory/Titer evidence for immunity.	Students born in or after 1957
Varicella (Chicken Pox)	One (1) dose at 12 months of age or later but before the student's 13 <sup>th</sup> birthday <b>OR</b> If first dose is given after student's 13 <sup>th</sup> birthday: Two (2) doses at least 4 weeks apart <b>OR</b> Medical history of varicella disease <b>OR</b> laboratory/Titer evidence of immunity.	All students
Tetanus, Diphtheria	One Td booster dose within 10 years prior to matriculation. *Recommendation: Students who are unable to document a primary series of three (3) doses of tetanus containing vaccine (DtaP, DTP, or Td) are strongly advised to complete a three (3) dose primary series with Td.	All students
Hepatitis B	Three (3) dose hepatitis B series (0, 1-2, and 4-6months) <b>OR</b> Three (3) dose combined hepatitis A and hepatitis B series (0, 1-2, and 6-12 months) <b>OR</b> Two (2) dose hepatitis B series of Recombivax (0 and 4-6 months, given at 11-15 years of age) <b>OR</b> Laboratory/Titer evidence of immunity prior to infection.	All students
