Math Placement Test

Students who wish to challenge their math course placement at Texas A&M University - Corpus Christi may take <u>ACCUPLACER's Next-Generation Advanced Algebra and Functions</u> exam in the Office of Academic Testing. It is a 90-minute, computer-adaptive exam with 20 questions.

The student must schedule a test appointment with the Office of Academic Testing. A \$15 math placement exam fee must be paid online prior to test date.

Exam Rules: The student is **not** permitted the use of any electronic devices (ex. cell phones) or testing aids (ex. calculators). The student may have a single piece of scratch paper. The exam must be completed without breaks.

Retest Policy: Students should be aware that they are only permitted to take the placement test once. Appeals to the retest policy will be made to the Math Department Chair. The appeal should explain why they believe a second attempt would improve their initial placement recommendation.

Course Placement: The assessment cut scores for this exam are as follows:
