#### What is it?


Available to newly enrolled Freshman students with an AGI (adjusted gross income) of \$125,000 or less and be Pell grant eligible.

#### What are the requirements?

- Must be a Texas Resident
- Must submit FAFSA by April 1 and be Pell Grant eligible
- Must maintain 2.5. GPA
- Must complete 15 credit hours each fall and spring semester at TAMUCC
