The College is under the administrative supervision of the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs, who reports to the University President. The College consists of three academic departments (Accounting, Business Law, and Finance; Decision Sciences and Economics; and Management and Marketing) and two Centers (South Texas Economic Development Center (STEDC); and Coastal Bend Business Innovation Center).

The College is headed by the Dean, who supervises the following administrative positions: the Associate Dean(s), Director of Master's Programs, Project Manager, Client Technologies Analyst, Assessment Technician, Business Coordinator, Chairs of the Academic Departments (Accounting, Business Law, and Finance; Decision Sciences and Economics; and Management and Marketing), Director of the Coastal Bend Business Innovation Center (CBBIC), and Director of the South Texas Economic Development Center (STEDC)

The Academic Advisors report to the University Director of Academic Advising, but consult and collaborate with the College Associate Dean(s) in interpreting certain course requirement substitutions or exceptions requested by undergraduate students and in interpreting AACSB accreditation guidelines related to degree requirements.
