
Joining a Grammarly for Education License

Users can join the Texas A&M System institutional license by following the instructions in the invitation links that will be sent to their email addresses.

Please be sure to provide the Grammarly team with your class rosters, so your students can be provided access to Grammarly. Rosters (user emails only) should be emailed to tamus@grammarly.com.

Students will be able to sign up for Grammarly access when they receive an email invitation from Grammarly. The email will be sent by hello@info.grammarly.com, and the subject line will be You're invited to join Texas A&M University System on Grammarly.

Getting Started

Once you've created and activated your Grammarly account, visit app.grammarly.com to access your account hub, where you can manage your settings and create new documents.

Installing Grammarly for Education

<u>Grammarly for Windows and Grammarly for Mac</u> are available options to seamlessly install the platform into your desktop. Once the application is installed, open any app or website on your computer and start typing. You will see a floating Grammarly widget on your screen. To integrate Al writing assistance into all the places you write, go to <u>app.grammarly.com</u> and open the Apps tab.

Writing and Editing with Grammarly


Now that you have installed Grammarly into your desktop and commonly used apps, you will start to receive real-time feedback and suggestions from Grammarly. Ensure your account is logged in and install the plug-in on your browser.

Clicking into the will display all edits, suggestions, and feedback. You can also navigate to the Generative AI menu through this pop up.





Here is an overview of the different elements you'll see on a suggestion card:








Personalization


The "Writing" tab allows you to customize and control language settings and writing style preferences. These settings help you receive personalized suggestions and ensure consistency in your writing.

You can select your primary language, the English dialect that you would like to receive suggestions for, and turn "fluency assistance" on.

You can also add words to your personal dictionary and personalize your writing styles.

If a setting is locked in "Writing Preferences", the setting has been preset for you. If a setting doesn't have a lock, you can choose to turn it on or off yourself.





Grammarly for Education Basics

Improving the quality of your writing is easy with Grammarly for Education and its robust communication features.

Correctness

Suggestions about spelling, grammar, and punctuation are underlined in red.

Engagement

Suggestions that make your writing more compelling, like word choice improvements, are underlined in green.

Brand Tones & Style Guide

Ensure your content is consistent and aligned with institution messaging with brand tones and style rules that appear when/where you write.

Clarity

Suggestions for making your writing easier to understand are underlined in blue.

Delivery


Suggestions that help you craft your message with the appropriate tone and attitude are underlined in purple.

Grammarly Generative Al







Generative Al

Leverage Grammarly's generative AI to provide students with a responsible AI tool that can support the entire writing process. Generative AI is enabled by the institution admin and individual users can deactivate Generative AI under their account settings.

- To start using Grammarly's generative AI features, click the lightbulb icon. You
 can choose from suggested academic prompts Grammarly offers based on your
 unique context or type your own custom prompt to get started.
- Grammarly's Al guideline reminders encourage students to honor their institutions' policies. Additionally, Grammarly's citation feature promotes transparency by allowing students to cite Al-use in their work in just a few clicks.
- Grammarly maintains uncompromising security standards and procedures to ensure that your words and account data are kept safe.















Plagiarism Checker and Al Detection

Grammarly's Plagiarism Checker will compare a student's writing to billions of web pages and academic papers and indicate where matching text was detected.

Once a reference is detected, a student can easily choose to copy it in their desired citation style (APA, MLA, Chicago Style).

Gramamarly's AI Detection feature highlights sections of your writing that match common AI writing patterns and that could be flagged as AI-generated.



With the Grammarly browser extension, a "Get citation" button will appear in the lower-left corner of compatible websites. Click it to generate a full citation and in-text citation, formatted in your chosen style.





Grammarly Analytics






Analytics

View your performance score, top tones detected, areas for improvement, and overall Grammarly usage. Watch <u>this video</u> for a live demo.








Group Analytics






Setting Up Writing Preferences for Your Class in Grammarly

To set up a custom writing preference set, navigate to the <u>Writing Preferences</u> <u>section</u>, create a new preference set and assign it to your class.








Style Rules







Translate with Grammarly

The translation feature allows you to translate text directly within Grammarly. This way, you can stay focused on your current work and minimize the need to switch to external translation tools.

- Click the lightbulb icon next to the Grammarly button to access the Generative AI menu
- In the assistant that opens, start typing "translate," and click Translate with Grammarly once this option appears.










Snippets

 Build and manage your snippet library with three easy ways to add new snippets.


