Faculty Advising/Mentoring Responsibilities

Faculty mentors work in collaboration with TAMU-CC Academic Advisors to support student success throughout their time at TAMUCC.

Faculty mentors are assigned to undergraduate students upon completion of 30 credit hours and to graduate students upon admission into graduate (MS, Ed.D., Ph.D.) programs. Faculty mentors support student queries and monitor student progress regarding subject/content specific issues related to post-graduation professionalization and career pursuits. Advisors provide additional information regarding the student enrollment and matriculation process.

Accessibility of Advising

Each semester, faculty are required to submit and post their schedule of university responsibilities using a form, which all departmental administrative associates have and will prepare, showing all class meetings, office hours, and other university commitments.

Advisors monitor, degree plan execution and clear students for graduation. Advisors are available for drop-in and appointment during regular university operational hours.
