TEKS: (K.4A) Students develop number and operations through several fundamental concepts. Students know number names and the counting sequence. Counting and cardinality lay a solid foundation for number. Students apply the principles of counting to make the connection between numbers and quantities.

Brief Summary: This trade book is designed to help kindergarten students learn and reinforce counting to ten and adding by groups of ten. The book uses photographs of actual size Cheerios as a familiar visual aid to teach the connection between numbers and quantities.

Materials needed: Bags of cheerios, Poster with circles, post-its with numbers on them
