Program offerings:

TUTORING

Tutors assist students with homework and practicing academic subjects. The tutors are college students trained and supported by experts.

ART

An artist affiliated with the Art Museum of South Texas provides daily art instruction. Students learn art history and explore various art forms and their own creativity. Student work is showcased on the Garcia Center walls.

LITERACY

Tutors teach guided reading and literacy to help students build comfort and appreciation for reading. Students have access to our library for silent reading, projects, and literacy games.

STEM

Math skills are taught and reinforced, and we have a computer lab that students can use with supervision. Tutors teach computer skills for writing and research.

COMMUNITY GARDEN

Students frequently work with our community garden, which teaches about the production, sustainability, nutrition and preparation of healthy food, while providing lessons in sciences, math (especially weights and measures), teamwork, and literacy.

WORKSHOPS & CULTURE

Students learn about rotating topics such as nutrition, diabetes, sun safety, Internet safety, water safety, and stranger danger. There are opportunities for activities such as the Art Museum of South Texas "Visionarios" contest, Dia de Los Muertos, Christmas art projects, the Cesar Chavez March, and Cinco de Mayo.
