### **1. Call to Order – Lori Podolsky / Judy Metcalf**

- Lori Podolsky called the meeting to order at **1:04 p.m.**

### **2. Approval of Minutes**

#### **a. October 30, 2025**

- Feri Billiot motioned to approve the October 30, 2025 meeting minutes with a second by Judith Metcalf.
- Seven in favor, zero opposed, zero abstentions.
- Motion carried with approval of meeting minutes.

### **3. Approval of Agenda / Amendment**

- Amendment: Move PADM items to the first set of course/program reviews to allow time for Chuck Etheridge to present before leaving for a conflicting appointment.
  - Motion to accept the agenda amendment: [noted by Lori; votes counted on screen]
  - Vote on amendment: majority in favor; no opposition, no abstentions.
- **Agenda as amended:**
  - Vote: Seven in favor, none opposed, no abstentions.
- Amended agenda approved.

### **4. Catalog Changes\***

#### **a. College of Liberal Arts**

- **PA DM (Public Administration) courses and program changes**
- Discussion:
  - Syllabi issues identified:

- Use of plus/minus grading scale inconsistent with institutional practice.
  - Missing or unclear course schedules (week 1, week 2, etc.) in some syllabi; partially resolved via department email responses.
  - Typos and outdated course numbers (e.g., PADM 6300) needing correction.
  - Inclusion of a “no recording” policy in syllabi.
- Resolutions:
  - Chuck Etheridge agreed to:
    - Remove all plus/minus grading references.
    - Correct course numbers, typos, and modality language (face-to-face/blended/online) to align with the multimodal program.
  - Recording policy:
    - Susan Murphy explained Texas is a **single-party consent state**, so an outright ban on recording is **not enforceable**.
    - Committee suggested revising language to emphasize concern about **dissemination/sharing** (e.g., posting lectures online), noting ongoing Faculty Senate/Provost discussions on intellectual property and sharing recorded content.
    - Chuck will notify faculty and adjust syllabi accordingly.
- Vote:
  - Motion to approve the PADM program and course package with the noted corrections: motioned by Lori Podolsky; seconded by Feri Billiot.
  - Seven in favor, zero opposed, zero abstentions.
  - Motion carried; PADM items approved with required revisions.

#### b. Tabled Items from October Meeting

- **HIST 2328 and HIST 4346** (College of Liberal Arts)
  - Motion to approve both courses: Feri Billiot; second by Tina Ybarra.
  - Vote: Seven in favor, one opposed (Miguel Moreno), zero abstentions.
  - Discussion focused on perceived overlap between HIST 2328 and HIST 4346.
    - Adam Costanzo explained that revised syllabi:
      - Differentiate lower-division vs. upper-division expectations.
      - Limit overlap to a single introductory reading; remaining readings differ.
    - Updated syllabi had not initially reached Miguel; Judith forwarded them during the meeting.
  - Courses remain approved as voted.
  - Process improvement: updated syllabi will be placed in a Teams “Updated Syllabi” folder for clearer access.
- **Architecture items (Del Mar)**
  - Confirmed as part of the **College of Engineering and Computer Science** package and treated as previously tabled items now included and acted on under that college (see 4e).

#### c. College of Business

- Items included:
  - Course additions
  - Program changes
  - One new minor program (personal finance / related area)
- Discussion:
  - **Additional new minors:**
    - Katherine Roberto noted that four new minors were submitted (personal finance/personal financial planning for business and non-business majors), but only one appeared on the agenda.
    - Susan Murphy and Jenny Vela clarified the other minors are still in workflow

(Dean/System step); Susan will move them forward.

- **BUSI 1301:**
  - Expedited item for course name and description change.
  - Request to add BUSI 1301 to the **university core** will be handled separately by the Core Curriculum Committee workflow.
- Vote:
  - Motion to approve the full College of Business catalog package (course additions, program changes, and the new minor program): Judy Metcalf; second by Felix Omoruyi.
  - Eight in favor, zero opposed, zero abstentions.
  - Motion carried; Business items approved.

#### **d. College of Education and Human Development**

- Items included:
  - Course additions
  - Course changes
  - Program changes
- Discussion:
  - No substantive concerns raised during the main vote segment.
- Vote:
  - Motion to move COEHD items forward for vote: Judy Metcalf; second by Feri Billiot.
  - Eight in favor, zero opposed, zero abstentions.
  - Motion carried; COEHD items approved.

#### **e. College of Engineering and Computer Science**

- Items included:
  - Course additions
  - Program changes
  - Architecture items from Del Mar (previously tabled, now included under this college's package).
- Vote:
  - Motion to approve the College of Engineering and Computer Science catalog package: Feri Billiot; second by Felix Omoruyi.
  - Eight in favor, zero opposed, zero abstentions.
  - Motion carried; Engineering, Computer Science, and Architecture items approved.

#### **f. College of Nursing and Health Sciences**

- Items:
  - One course (Nursing and Health Sciences) for catalog change.
- Vote:
  - Motion to approve: Tina Ybarra; second by Feri Billiot.
  - Eight in favor, zero opposed, zero abstentions.
  - Motion carried; Nursing and Health Sciences course approved.

#### **g. Other**

- Items:
  - Honors Capstone course
  - Global Career Accelerator course
  - Addition of Honors Capstone Experience as an option within the Honors Program
- Discussion:
  - Brief clarification of items; no major concerns raised.
- Vote:
  - Motion to approve all three "Other" items: Judy Metcalf; seconded by Feri Billiot
  - Eight in favor, zero opposed, zero abstentions.

- Motion carried; all “Other” items approved.

### **Expedited Items (Information Only – Under Chair’s Purview)**

- Items discussed (Graduate-level EDAD courses related to principal certification):
  - EDAD 6377 / 5377 – Teacher Appraisal System
  - EDAD 6397 / 5391 – related leadership courses
- Discussion:
  - Concern raised by Miguel Moreno that, unlike some other 5000/6000 cross-listed courses, these did not include an exclusionary statement (e.g., “students who have taken \_\_ may not enroll in \_\_”).
  - Context provided by Kevin Bazner and Denise Lara:
    - These courses are tied to TEA principal certification and repeat enrollment at a different level may be necessary in limited exception cases (e.g., expired certification, never sat for exam).
    - Advising practices and degree plans generally prevent inappropriate double-enrollment; adding a blanket exclusion might interfere with legitimate certification needs and cause confusion.
  - Susan Murphy clarified:
    - Expedited items are under the UCC Chair’s discretion and do not require a committee vote.
    - Chair may choose to send them back or approve them after considering the discussion.
- Outcome:
  - No formal action or vote taken; discussion deemed sufficient.
  - Chair may proceed with expedited review and approvals as appropriate.
