## Section 12.01 INSURANCE – SUMMER CAMPS

Accident/Medical and Liability insurance are required for all youth programs sponsored by the university. All summer camp insurance applications will need to be completed at the TAMUS Office of Risk Management website in Origami located at https://live.origamirisk.com/Origami/IncidentEntry/Welcome . When the camp has ended appropriate department reporter must go into Origami to enter final participant numbers. Once entered, an invoice will be sent via email and Environmental Health & Safety office will process through Islander Buy. Summer camp insurance is intended to insure K-12th grade students. It should not be purchased for college students or the general public.
