


How to Find Your Physical (MAC) Address

All devices that have the ability to connect to the network have a physical address. Follow the instructions below to find yours.

Windows 7

1. Click the Start Button in the bottom left hand corner.
2. Type "cmd" in the Search bar and hit enter.
3. Once the Command Prompt Window pops up type, "getmac" and hit enter.



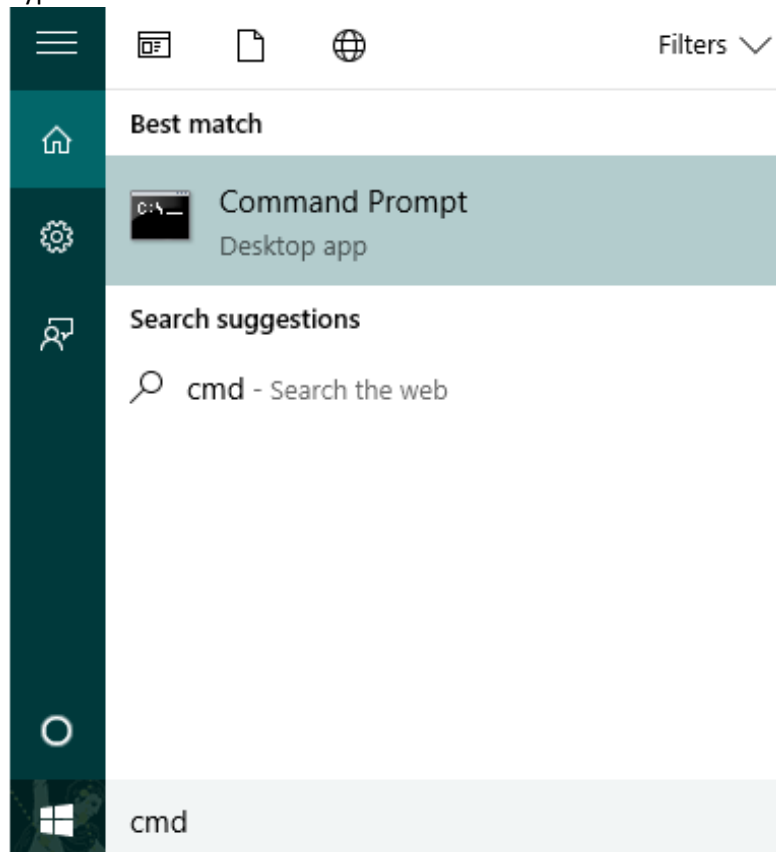

Windows 10

1. Type "cmd" in the Search bar on the toolbar and hit enter.



2. Once the Command Prompt Window pops up type, "getmac" and hit enter.

Mac OS X

1. Click the Apple icon in the upper left hand corner.
2. Select System Preferences>Network>Ethernet>Advanced>Hardware.
