Criteria for Identification of Creditable Field Work For

The potential contracted field experience must have the following characteristics:

- Student must be required to perform extensive problem analysis which results in the development of a software program or formal analysis report, either individually or as a member of a professional team
- Student project (for CSI or CIS options) could be the design and implementation of a secure network infrastructure, which could be done individually or as part of a team.
- Student must interact with superiors, peers and client personnel.
- Student must not be simply serving as an IT person who installs or inventories equipment.
- Student work must involve formal written documentation, in addition to weekly reports to the COSC 4690 Instructor.
