- Submit official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended

Applicants that have less than 24 transferable credit hours will need to submit their official high school transcript.

Submit your FAFSA at studentaid.gov. TAMU-CC school code #011161.

NOTE

Obtaining automatic admission to the University holds no extra enrollment conditions for applicants. Additional requirements may exist for those pursuing certain degree programs like nursing, engineering, graphic design, music, and theatre.
