- Founded in 1959 as a hospital-based program at Christus Spohn Shoreline, the Clinical Laboratory Science Program joined the now Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi in 1975. Over a 12-month period, the program educates students to become clinical laboratory professionals that are qualified to work in hospitals, clinics, public health laboratories, physician's offices, research, sales, and consulting.
- Essential members of the healthcare team, clinical laboratory scientists are responsible for a variety of chemical, hematological, immunological, microbiological, serological, and other laboratory procedures that are required in over seventy percent of all patient diagnoses.




