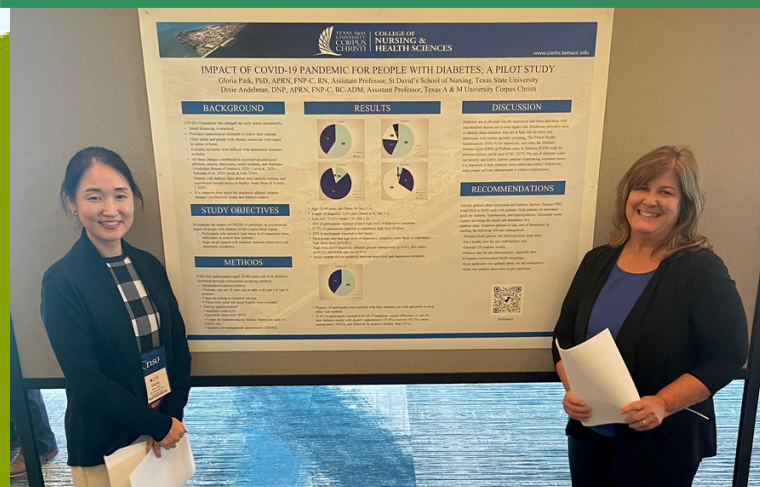


WELL DONE

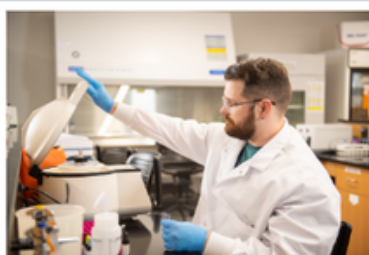
