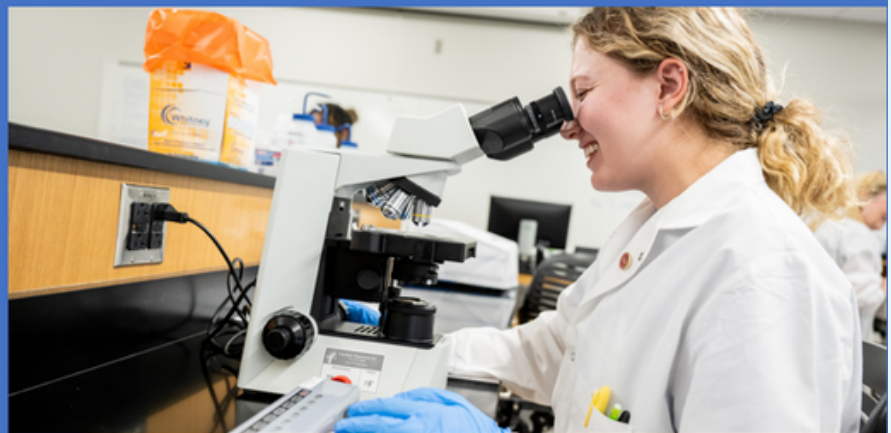

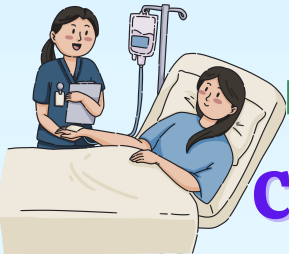

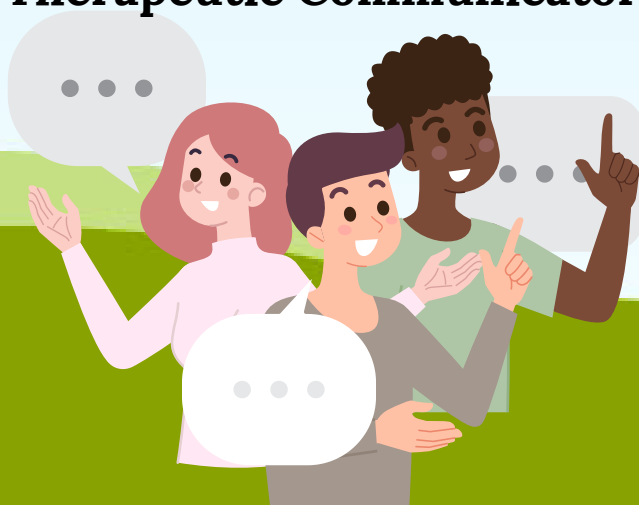
CONHS Simulation Lab – Oncology
